- Assist with Palm programs as needed

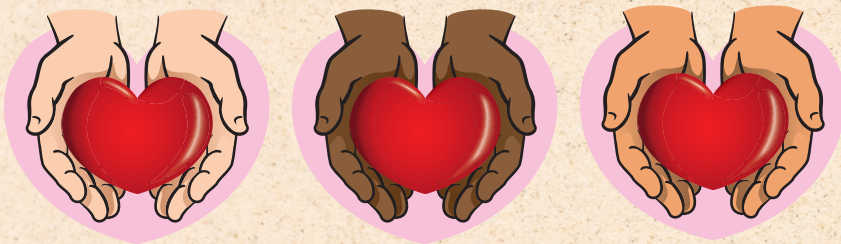
